

Waltham, Watertown to Brighton Reliability Project Start of Construction Notice – May 2024

Dear Neighbor,

As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers, we want to let you know we will soon be starting construction of the Waltham, Watertown to Brighton Reliability Project ("Project"). Crews will begin setting up work areas starting as early as June 2024, to begin preconstruction field surveys ahead of construction. This Project is one of several that are designed to improve the reliability of the electric system serving Greater Boston. Please be assured that this work will not interrupt your electrical service.

We're Always Working to Serve You Better

The upcoming work by Eversource's contractor **McCourt Construction** involves replacing two existing underground electric transmission cables. The two lines run parallel for almost 6 miles between Eversource substations in Waltham, Watertown, and Brighton. Most of the work will take place at the existing underground manhole locations within city streets. Excavation will be necessary in some areas based on conditions in the field. Within the next few weeks, crews from **McCourt Construction** will begin working to make these improvements. All people working on this project are Eversource-approved contractors and carry proper identification.

At the same time, Eversource contractors will be making upgrades to install new equipment at the Waltham Substation located off Hillside Road. These upgrades include replacing several transformers on Eversource property inside the substation. Work here is expected to last 12 months and begin as early as July 2024. Property owners living near the substation may receive additional notifications based on the scope of work and deliveries to the site. Additional upgrades and activities will be occurring at the Watertown Substation, located at the corner of Arsenal Street and Irving Street, as part of this Project.

Project Duration

We anticipate the entire Reliability Project to take 24 months to complete, however, work at each underground manhole location will be occurring intermittently during that period. Project construction will take place in phases, and you can expect to see crews at different times throughout the course of the Project.



What You Can Expect

Construction Hours: General work hours are Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Some work may extend beyond normal work hours based on approval from municipal officials. There will be certain activities that must take place continuously, 24 hours a day, for approximately one week at each manhole location. Nearby property owners will be notified before the 24/7 work begins.

Project Activities:

- Setting up a safe and secure work site.
- Opening the manholes; performing testing, inspections and dewatering in some instances.
- Excavation to access underground pipe and cables and install new manholes in select locations.
- Upgrading equipment at Eversource Substations in Waltham, Watertown, and Brighton.
- Removing the existing cable.
- Pulling new cable into place.
- Joining together (splicing) new cable.

Manhole Locations: Below is a list of the manhole locations and proposed new buried splice along the project route where most of the activities for the Project will occur.
